Learning content

- Citizenship education
- Critical thinking, media literacy

Learning environment

- Open classroom climate
- Whole school approach; support for community involvement

Learning resources

- Council of Europe Democratic Culture Framework
- Output from ET2020 working group etc.



2. Inclusive education



Access

- Including all pupils in quality education
- Acknowledging importance of early childhood education & care

Support

 Enabling inclusion by providing support to learners according to their needs

Transitions

 Helping students navigate educational levels-educational and career guidance

Teacher training

- Initial and ongoing teacher training on
 - Conveying common values
 - Responding to learners' diverse needs

Mentoring and support

 Teacher exchanges; peer learning; guidance and mentoring.

- Structural and investment funds
